# Career Technical Education

CTE provides motivated students with a sequence of courses preparing them for college and satisfying careers in their areas of interest. Each option at Hart High School consists of a combination of school-based and work-based experiences. It is a two-tiered system with students being granted certificates of completion or mastery, depending on their level of achievement and commitment.
